India is a very big country in Asia. The capital is New Delhi. People from India are Indian. English is very important here. A famous symbol is the beautiful white building, the Taj Mahal.

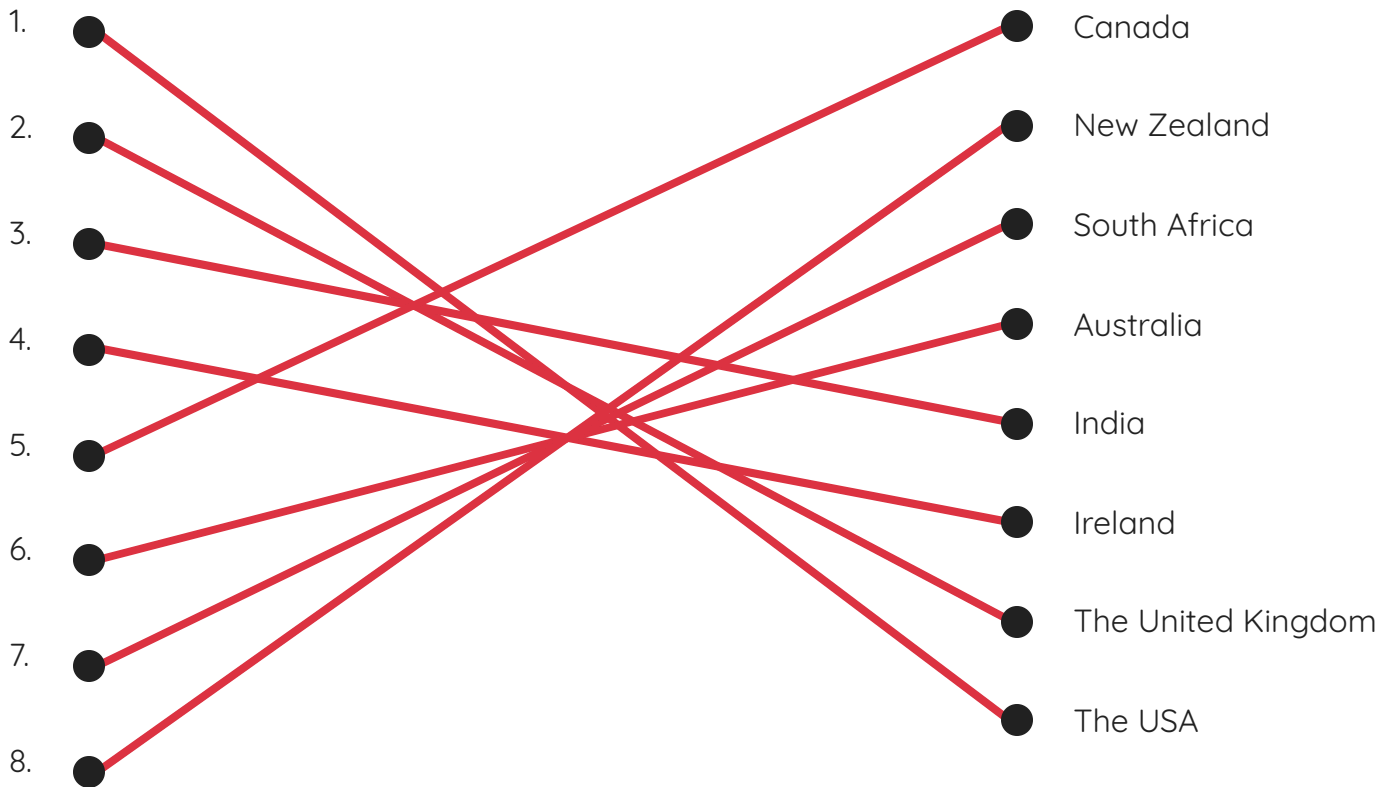
